## What is an Events Volunteer?

An events volunteer adds value to our special events throughout the season; they help to create lasting memories for our visitors. The role includes working with people of all ages, including children.

## What's involved?

- Face to face interaction with visitors.
- Promoting Sacrewell and the work of the William Scott Abbott Trust.
- Supporting the Sacrewell team with the logistics of the event such as car parking, litter picking and installing temporary signage.
- Supporting the Sacrewell team to ensure the everyday running of the centre goes smoothly during events.
- Helping us to improve and expand our events programme by sharing and developing your own ideas.
- Becoming familiar with and then following Sacrewell's Health and Safety Policy at all times.
- Other activities and opportunities may be offered.
